Whereas, there are many instances of motorists violating traffic laws requiring that motorists stop at a red light, and

Whereas, there are automated systems available to the City of Selma to assist the Police Department in the enforcement of traffic laws without requiring additional staffing or expense to the Police Department or the City of Selma, and


Whereas, there will be no net out of pocket cost to the City of Selma for the installation and operation of the automated red light enforcement system, and


Now Therefore Be It Resolved, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that the Mayor be authorized to negotiate and enter into an Agreement with American Traffic Solutions, Inc. to provide an automated red light enforcement system in compliance with the local legislation passed by the Alabama Legislature at its earliest possible date, and

Be It Finally Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama has determined that the services to be provided by American Traffic Solutions, Inc. are, and do constitute, a Professional Service as defined in Code of Alabama, 1975, §41-16-21(a) as amended.
