Survey of Historic African-American Neighborhoods

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a United States Department of Interior Grant from the Alabama Historic Commission in the amount of \$4,000.00 to survey historic African-American neighborhoods; *and*

WHEREAS, the City began this survey several years ago and committed to its completion; *and*

WHEREAS, the State has offered \$4,000.00 to continue the project if the City provides a \$4,000.00 match; *and*

WHEREAS, the \$4,000.00 match will be obligated from any remaining funds in the 2010-2011 grant match budget line item; *and*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to sign all appropriate letters, forms and documents necessary for the receipt of the grant funds.


